- A statement of relevant experience providing or volunteering in spiritual care,
- Training or courses specific to hospital chaplaincy
- Names of two- character references

Applicants should send either a letter of reference from their priest / parish administrator or member of the clergy with their contact information to verify their support for your application.

The individual who obtains the position must be able to obtain a **Vulnerable Sector Search** through their local police service.

Preference will be given to people who have completed the CPE courses or equivalent education in spiritual care.

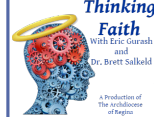
